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What is LNG?

Liquefied natural gas – LNG for short – is natural gas (methane) in liquid form. The LNG we produce is loaded on ships and transported around the world. When it reaches its destination, it is turned back into gas (regasification) and then transported via pipeline to homes and businesses where it is used as an energy source.

Benefits of LNG

- Burns cleaner than other fuels, reducing emissions by as much as 30% - 40%

- Allows for convenient storage of natural gas
- Supports domestic natural gas production capacity
- Promotes stability in natural gas pricing
- Potential to displace oil and coal for power generation applications, resulting in reduced global CO² emissions

Sabine Pass Liquefaction (SPL) - located on over 1,000 acres in Cameron Parish, Louisiana - two miles east of the Texas Border

- First LNG export project in the lower 48
- 6 operational trains
- Over 2,000 cargoes produced
- 5 storage tanks (17 Bcfe)
- ~4 nautical miles from coast

- Three berths
- Aggregate nominal production capacity of SPL is approximately 30 mtpa of LNG, and more than 4.7 billion cubic feet per day of natural gas is processed into LNG
- ~950 employees and contractors
